



CRUISE PARTNER AGREEMENT

Description

Ebony Pyramid Entertainment (EPE) is entering into an Agreement with the Cruise Partner, listed above. The Cruise Partner will promote EPE's annual Black Gay and Lesbian Pride: Caribbean Cruisin' – Bahamas (Event) by means of their website, newsletters (online and/or electronic), blogs, flyers, posters, on-site promotions (at no cost), and other promotional means set forth by EPE. This excludes means when Cruise Partners are charging for services, such as advertisement in a program booklet/guide or situations that would incur a cost to the Cruise Partner.

In exchange, EPE will list the Cruise Partner on its website as a Cruise Partner with a link to the Cruise Partner's website. In addition, EPE will list the Cruise Partner in the Event's Official Program Guide.

Qualification

In order to qualify as a Cruise Partner, the organization must: 1) have been in business for a minimum of two years, 2) have a website, and send out an email blast at least twice a month.

Requirements

Website: When promoting EPE on a Cruise Partner website, the advertisement/banner must be in a prominent location. EPE must approve the positioning of the advertisement/banner. This does not expressly require the Cruise Partner to place the advertisement/banner on the Home Page of a Cruise Partner.

Email Blast: This does not require that a Cruise Partner send out an email blast specifically advertising EPE (unless they want), but that in the email blast, the EPE advertisement/banner must be included.

EPE will provide the advertisement/banner to the Cruise Partner, with the referral language.

Compensation

The Cruise Partners will be compensated by EPE by paying Five Percent (5%) of the Cruise Rate Only for all NEW guests referred, after the first five. New guests are defined as guests that have never been booked, on the Event, with EPE from 1999 to Present.

In order to receive a cash commission, the Cruise Partner will receive \$10 for the first five guests. The \$10 per guest will not be paid, until the fifth guest has been reached. After the fifth guest, the Five Percent (5%) per guest of the Cruise Rate will be paid.

The commission scale is:

<u>Number of Guests</u>	<u>Commission Paid</u>
1 – 4	\$10 per guest (Not Paid)
5	\$50
6 – 24	5% of the Cruise Rate – per guest
25 -	8% of the Cruise Rate – per guest

No commissions will be paid on guests that receive a free or discounted cruise.

Once the Cruise Partner reaches Fifteen (15) guests, EPE will provide them with two (2) twenty percent (20%) off Cruise Rate credits, to use as they see fit. This offer cannot be used with any other credits and will not be counted towards commission.

Payments will be dispersed to Cruise Partners by the First (1st) and Third (3rd) Friday of each month and paid via Pay Pal. EPE is not responsible for any fees assessed to Cruise Partner by Pay Pal. If Cruise Partner requests payment be made by Cashier's Check then there will be a fee of \$10 for commissions up to \$50, a \$15 fee for commissions of \$51 - \$100, and a fee of \$20 for commissions of \$101 and up.

Verification of Credit

EPE will provide advertisement/banner for Cruise Partner's website that will state for website visitors to list the Cruise Partner's name on the EPE Registration Form, when they register for the cruise. The Cruise Partner's name will be listed in a drop down box on the form. The Cruise Partner may also place a sticker, without covering up prime images or information, on EPE flyers with their name and to list them as a "Referral".

EPE will use the guests' registration forms to determine which Cruise Partner to credit for the referral. A guest cannot come back and complete a registration form later and then change their Referral name. Sometimes guests make mistakes and change registration information. But, after an hour of the first registration, a guest cannot change their Referral name. They may change or correct any other information, but not their Referral information. This means that if a guest registered weeks or months earlier, they cannot now register and list the Cruise Partner as a Referral.

When submitting commission to the Cruise Partner, EPE will provide the guests First Name and Last Name Initial (example: John D.). This is to protect the identity of the guest. Other guest information will not be provided to Cruise Partners. If the Cruise Partner has a challenge because they think that one of their referred guests has registered and paid their deposit and EPE did not pay the Cruise Partner commission, the Cruise Partner may challenge EPE. In order to challenge EPE, the Cruise Partner must provide EPE with the guest's First and Last Name. If it is found that EPE did not pay the Cruise Partner their deserved commission, EPE will pay them their percentage, plus \$10. If it is found that the guest has not registered and/or paid their deposit or if the guest is found to have registered earlier without listing the Cruise Partner, then the Cruise Partner must pay EPE \$25 per challenge. If the Cruise Partner does not pay the \$25 challenge fee, they will not be eligible for further commissions for that year and subject to disqualification for future years.

Timeline

This Agreement will be in effect from the signing of the Agreement until September 5, 2008.

Company Image

This Agreement does not endorse the action or business practice of the Cruise Partner, nor does it acknowledge that the Cruise Partner has any other business matters or agreements with EPE, other than what is outlined in this Agreement. Cruise Partner acknowledges that it will not name EPE in any suits, based on it partnership with EPE, for their own actions.

Termination of Agreement

EPE may option to terminate this Agreement if it feels that the Cruise Partner is not complying with the guidelines in the Agreement. Prior to the terminating the Agreement, EPE must give at least one verbal or written warning, unless the incident is so egregious that EPE feels it constitutes immediate termination.

The Cruise Partner may request termination at any time.
