Group Dynamics

This Association and Organization Group must have on its rosters a minimum of 25 (twenty-five) guests or 13 (thirteen) cabins. The absolute minimum for records is 13 (thirteen) cabins. So, the group may use any combination of occupancy (single, double, triple, or quad) to make up the cabin requirement.

The Group Coordinator (GC) must list all names of group members (prior to their individual reservations online). There may be no To Be Announced (TBA). All members must be named and paired with their designated cabin mates. Once all group members' names are received and this agreement is signed, then each group member is responsible for registering online by the deadline provided by Ebony Pyramid Entertainment (EPE). Failure to meet the individual registration may void all discounts for each group member.

Group Coordinator

The Group Coordinator is responsible for all of the administrative concerns of the group. The GC is also responsible to be the liaison for their group members to EPE. For this service, the GC will receive a discounted rate of \$295 for a Double Occupancy – Inside Cabin. The GC's cabin mate must pay the regular rate (minus the group discount). If the GC wishes to upgrade the cabin to an Oceanview, the GC must pay \$125 for the upgrade and the cabin mate must pay the regular rate (minus the discount). Should the GC want to have a Single Occupancy – Inside Cabin, they must pay a rate of \$450. If the GC wants to upgrade to a Single Occupancy – Oceanview Cabin, they must add the \$125 upgrade fee to the Single Occupancy – Inside Cabin rate.

Cost & Payments

The cost for the members of this group shall be the advertised price, minus 10% (ten

percent) discount off the cruise price only. The 10% (ten percent) discount does not apply to quad occupancy bookings, but the cabin will count for minimum cabin requirements.

Any other additions to the group member's bill will be added to the overall cost at the normal rate (i.e., insurance, pre-cruise, etc.).

The initial deposit amount must be paid by the Group Coordinator on behalf of each group member. The payment must be made by organization check, money order, or credit card. Monthly payments thereafter must be made on behalf of the group by the GC. Group members will be subjected to the late fee penalties outlined in the Statement of Understanding (which must be signed by each group member).

Benefit for the Group/Association

In addition to the 10% (ten percent) discount to each guest member, EPE will provide the Group/Association \$20 (twenty dollars) per guest member on their roster (minus those in quad occupancy cabins). This amount will only be paid after the Final Payment Date.

Guidelines To Follow

Each group member is bound by the EPE Statement of Understanding in all matters, except when it comes to Group Breeches (which is discussed later in this document). It is the responsibility of the GC to allow each group member to review this Agreement.

Group Breeches

This group must never go below its minimum cabin requirements. If a guest cancels or is cancelled by EPE, the group must ensure that it maintains the minimum cabin requirement. So, it is best that on a group's initial roster, they make allowances for possible cancellations.

Should the group fall below its minimum cabin requirement, each guest's account will increase to reflect the current rate (at the time of the breach). This means that the discount will be removed and each guest's cabin cost will be based on current rates (for example: if at the time of group booking, a double occupancy rate was \$580 and your group discount was off of that rate and the group breeches and the current double occupancy rate is now \$595, then each guest will be charged the new rate of \$595 and the account will be adjusted reflecting any payments made thus far). If this breach occurs, the group member may request a cancellation based on the cancellation outline in the Statement of Understanding.

This breach also applies to the Group Coordinator. If a breach occurs, then the GC will be responsible for the current rate of the chosen cabin.

Group Member Substitution

If the group is in jeopardy of going below its minimum cabin requirement, the GC may not add new members to substitute for ones being removed. The only time this can occur is when the group member has paid in FULL and that member makes a "Name Change"

and pays the fee for the action.

Cruise Documents/Boarding Passes

All Cruise Documents/Boarding Passes will be sent to the GC for coordination, regardless of the group members' region or location.

Timeline

This offer will be extended to groups from December 15, 2006 to June 1, 2007.
